We had announced that all 3 of our competitions were scheduled to be “in person” in York, PA. After many discussions with the York Expo center unfortunately, due to the recent surge in COVID cases, we have decided to make our first event, the Jingle Bell Battle a “VIRTUAL” event.

We still PLAN to still hold our “IN PERSON” events, the Blizzard Battle, January 23, 2021 AND our Keystone Championship, March 6, 2021!

Fingers crossed things improve for the rest of the season.

We are including information on our VIRTUAL Jingle Bell Battle and we hope to see lots of teams participate, as we know that all of the athletes need a reason to compete.

So what happens if we pay for January or March and they get cancelled?

We know how hard you work to raise funds to have your athletes compete. We will be offering a 100% refund should the venue decide to close. In fact, that will be offered for all of our competition dates. If for some reason the York Expo Center has to close down, we will refund all fees paid for that competition. You will have the choice to move the funds to our next competition.

Covid Concerns?

We are taking steps, as well as the York Expo Center to keep our athletes and spectators as safe as possible this competition season. We will be requiring masks for fans, and while the athletes move around the competition. However, we will allow athletes to warm up and compete without the masks.

We will be spacing spectators and teams out so that less people will be in the venue at a time. We will continue our efforts to provide safe competitions, as we get closer to the events more detailed information will be sent regarding COVID procedures.

How does it work?

Teams will film in their own facility, our virtual event format does not require that all participating teams be present in their gyms at the same time or on the same day. ALL Videos MUST be time stamped/recorded within the dates of December 1, 2020 and December 9, 2020.

Once routines are filmed, they will be uploaded to a Google Drive and the link will be emailed to Combat Cheer & Dance . There is no need to purchase additional equipment....you can simply film on your phone or available camera. Our certified judging panel will score the routines and score sheets will be emailed to coaches, just like at an in-person event.

Team Placements will be announced online on Monday, December 14, link will be emailed to teams and are FREE to watch.

What Divisions will be offered?

All divisions including Recreation Game Day/Traditional and NA/Performance Rec, School, and All Star Cheer and Dance are welcome to compete. Recreation Teams will be following YCADA rules and divisions, School will be following PIAA, and All Star will be following USASF. Recreation divisions will both offer NON building divisions too.

What awards will be given?

Combat Cheer and Dance is happy to be giving Banners to the Top 3 teams in EACH division.

In addition, we will be giving away “Specialty Banners” to a Variety of categories including “Best Overall Choreography, Best Jumps, Best Tumbling, Best Dance, and Best Stunts.” There will be addition awards given out for Level Champions for All Star divisions.

GRAND CHAMPIONS FOR RECREATION, SCHOOL AND ALL STAR WILL RECEIVE:
Banners, FREE registration to our 2021 Blizzard Battle OR 2021 Keystone Championship, PLUS EACH Athlete will receive a gift too!

Video guidelines:

Teams must submit a video recording of their routine taken in their practice facility, and will be given a Combat “Pass Phrase” that will need to be included in the video recording. Videos must be one take – edited footage will not be accepted. All 4 corners of the floor should be visible and should be a USASF approved surface. The program must own rights to this video and consent to it, or portions of it to being posted on the Combat Cheer and Dance web site, facebook and/or youtube channel for awards and advertisement purposes..

Rosters:

Team rosters will be required for all teams to participate in the Combat Cheer & Dance JINGLE BELL BATTLE Virtual Competition and must be emailed to: combatcheeranddance@gmail.com prior to December 10, 2020.

What should teams wear?

Your team can wear their uniforms or practice wear, it is up to you. For best viewing, team members should be dressed alike or similar. All star teams must follow USASF, Schools PIAA, and Recreation must follow YCADA general rules when it comes to uniform guidelines.

How will our team be judged?

Once routine videos are uploaded our certified judging panel will score the routines. Score sheets will be emailed to coaches. Should you need clarification on a deduction or have a scoring question we will do our best to get you an answer from our judging panel. Decisions made by the judges will be final.

Where can we watch awards?

Awards for our Virtual Competition will be FREE to all viewers on Monday, December 14 at 7 p.m. Each coach will be provided a link.

How will we receive our banners or specialty awards should we win?

We will be mailing banners and other items directly to the coach/gym. A form will be emailed to coaches of any winning team for them to fill out and return following awards.

IMPORTANT Registration Information—

- * In order to be in the running for the CASH Prize at the Keystone Championship, that TEAM must attend ONE of the Qualifiers (Jingle Bell Battle OR Blizzard Battle)
- * Waivers must be sent 2 weeks prior to competition date OR brought to the competition registration desk. NO Athletes will be allowed to compete without a signed waiver.
- * We follow USASF age grids and rules for AllStar Teams, we follow PIAA for schools. We will be using YCADA rules for Recreation divisions.
- * We reserve the right to combine or split divisions based on size of team, level, co-ed, etc... as needed.
- * Registration Fees are non refundable, in the event your team cannot attend after registration has been received, you may transfer your fees to another event. *NOTE: Due to the everchanging Covid regulations we will be allowing teams to receive Refunds or transfer funds to another event this season.*
- * If your team needs to reduce participants, there is no refunds. There is no refunds for No Shows, or Drop outs the day of the event.
- * In the event of inclement weather, if the facility is open the event will go on. If WSYAA decides to cancel the event, your registration will be applied to the rescheduled event. If WSYAA does not reschedule the event, or another event is not available, a full refund will be given to your team.
